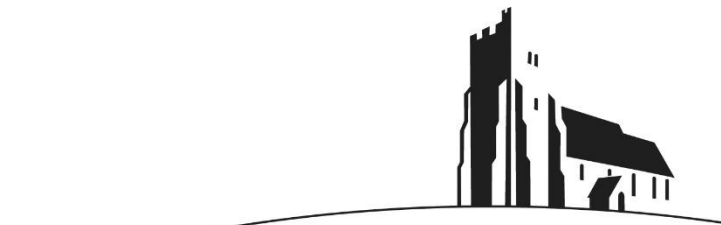
The website states its values as:
