MISSION SUPPORT FOR SEPTEMBER – UCCF

Christian Unions are groups of young people who gather together to support one another in their faith, whether at school, college or university. At a time when Christian values seem generally to be waning in the West, university or college is often a time when young people are open to exploring new ideas. This can be a crucial time for young Christians as they stand firm and witness to their faith. Led by students CUs can be mission teams operating at the heart of campuses. UCCF exists to support these young Christians as they live out their faith and try to reach their friends for Jesus. Forty-seven Staff Workers work across campuses nationwide encouraging, advising and providing resources, while recent graduates called 'Relay Workers', are there on a ten month programme to support at a more local level, together with local churches.

Recently UCCF launched a new Bible study resource called Uncover Luke. This has proved to be a wonderful aid for CU members as they seek to help their interested friends. One student says, "I'm really excited about Uncover Luke because it empowers the people in my CU who might not feel super confident.....to speak about Jesus to their friends without feeling they need to have all the answers".

Please pray this month for Christian students as they use this resource. Also pray for good contacts in freshers' weeks, for CU committees as they plan events, for the ever popular carol services later in the coming term, and for churches as they provide support for their local CUs. Today's undergraduates may be the leaders of the future. How wonderful if many of them could be Christians!
